**Flexible Instructional Days (FIDs) 2021-2022**

A Flexible Instructional Day (FID) is a program available to public school entities to be used as an alternate approach to delivering instruction if a circumstance arises that prevents instruction in a customary manner.

DSD will often utilize FIDs when weather necessitates the closure of school.

The decision to utilize a FID will be announced via the automated calling/text system and via local media. Update your contact information in our automated calling/text system as needed.

Faculty and students do not report to campus during a FID (similar to a traditional “snow day.”)

**FID Reminders:**

- Students will be expected to participate in coursework on FIDs via Google Classroom and/or by utilizing materials and resources prepared and distributed prior to the FID.
- When inclement weather is predicted students will be reminded to take Chromebooks and related materials home prior when possible.
- Attendance will be monitored and the participation will be assessed on FIDs.
- Teachers, guidance counselors, nurses, related services, and principals will be available via email during FIDs.
- FIDs will not be utilized during delays or early dismissals.
- When a FID is utilized the school day does not need to be made up in place of scheduled holidays or at the end of the school year.
- Additional details regarding FIDs may be communicated via your child’s teacher(s).
